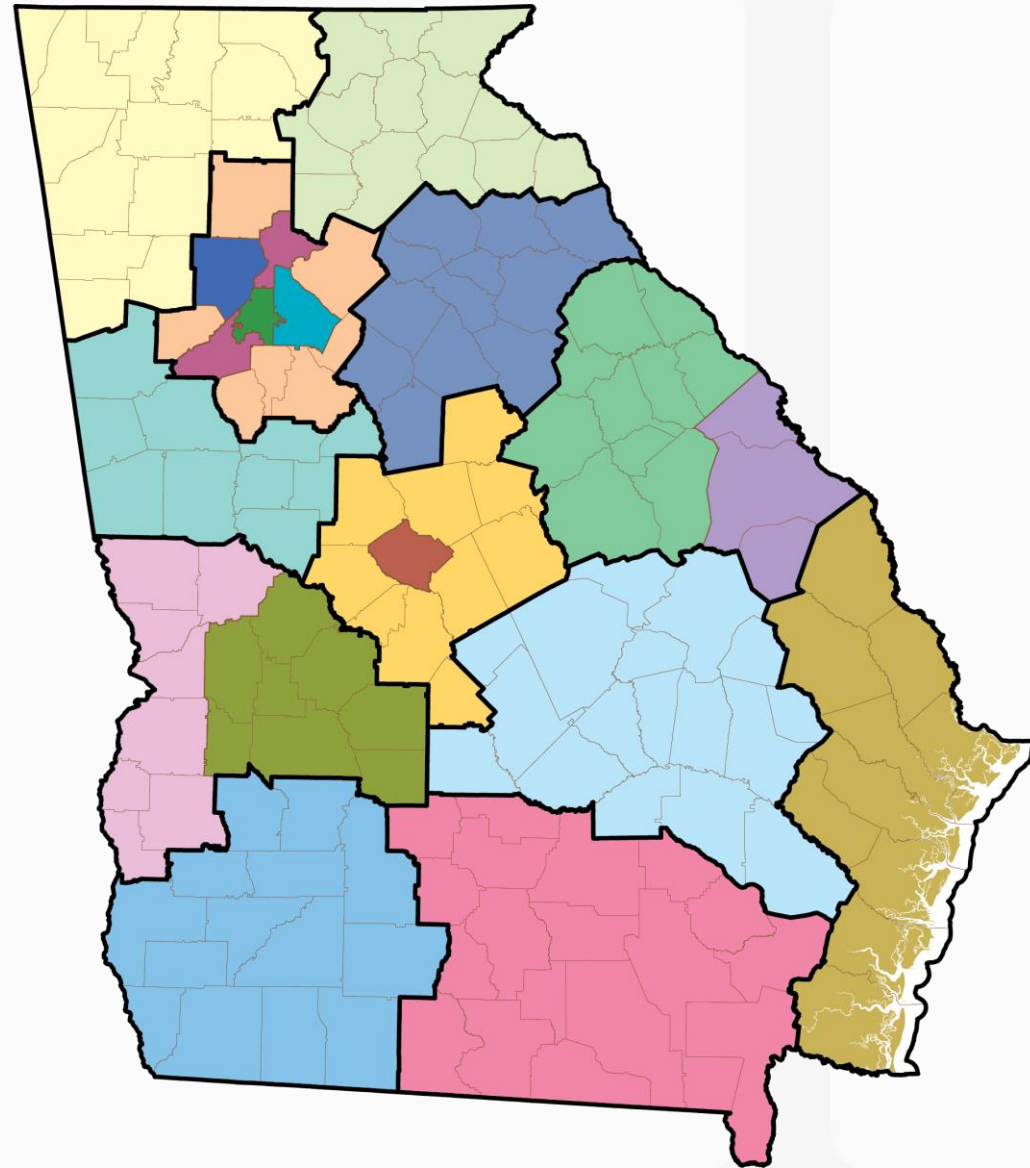

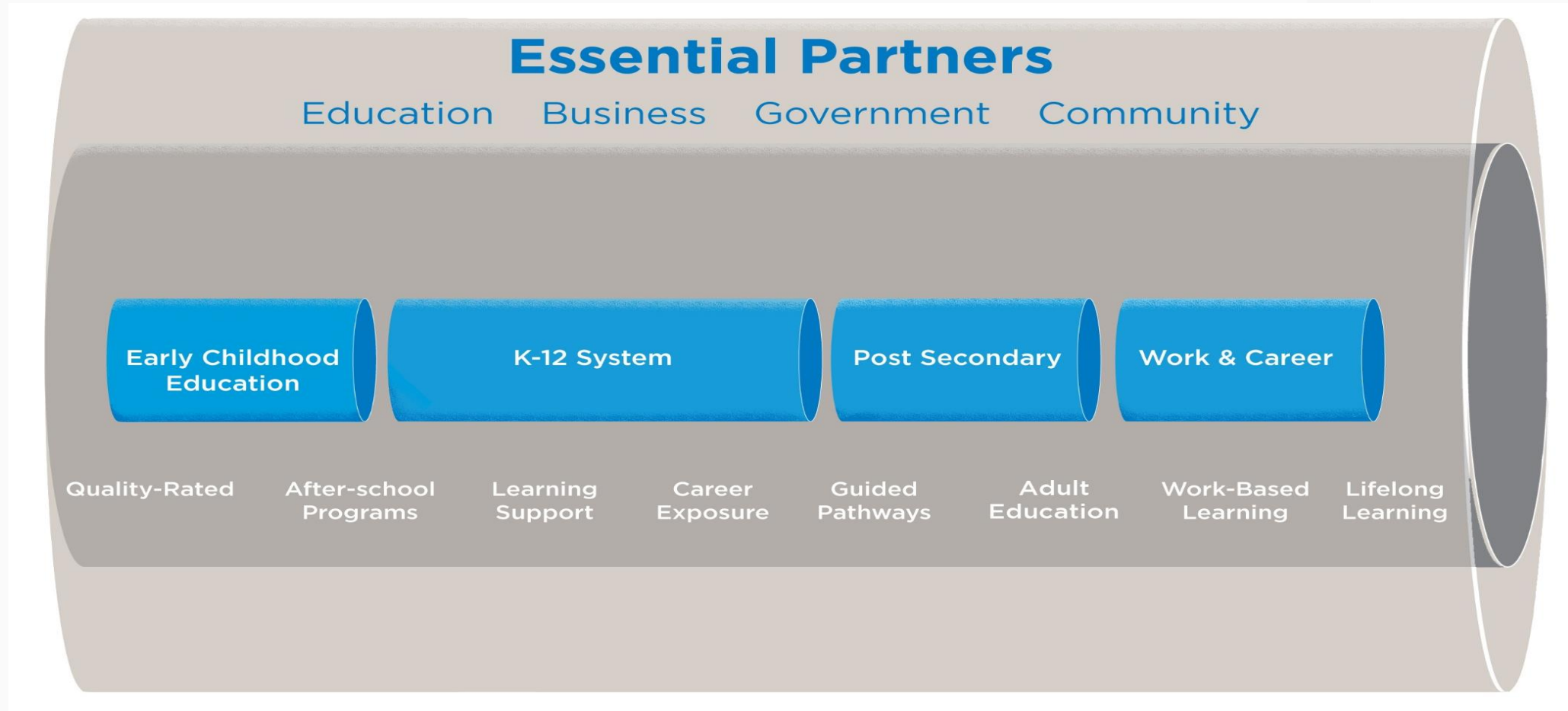


What is a sector partnership?

Workforce Pipeline

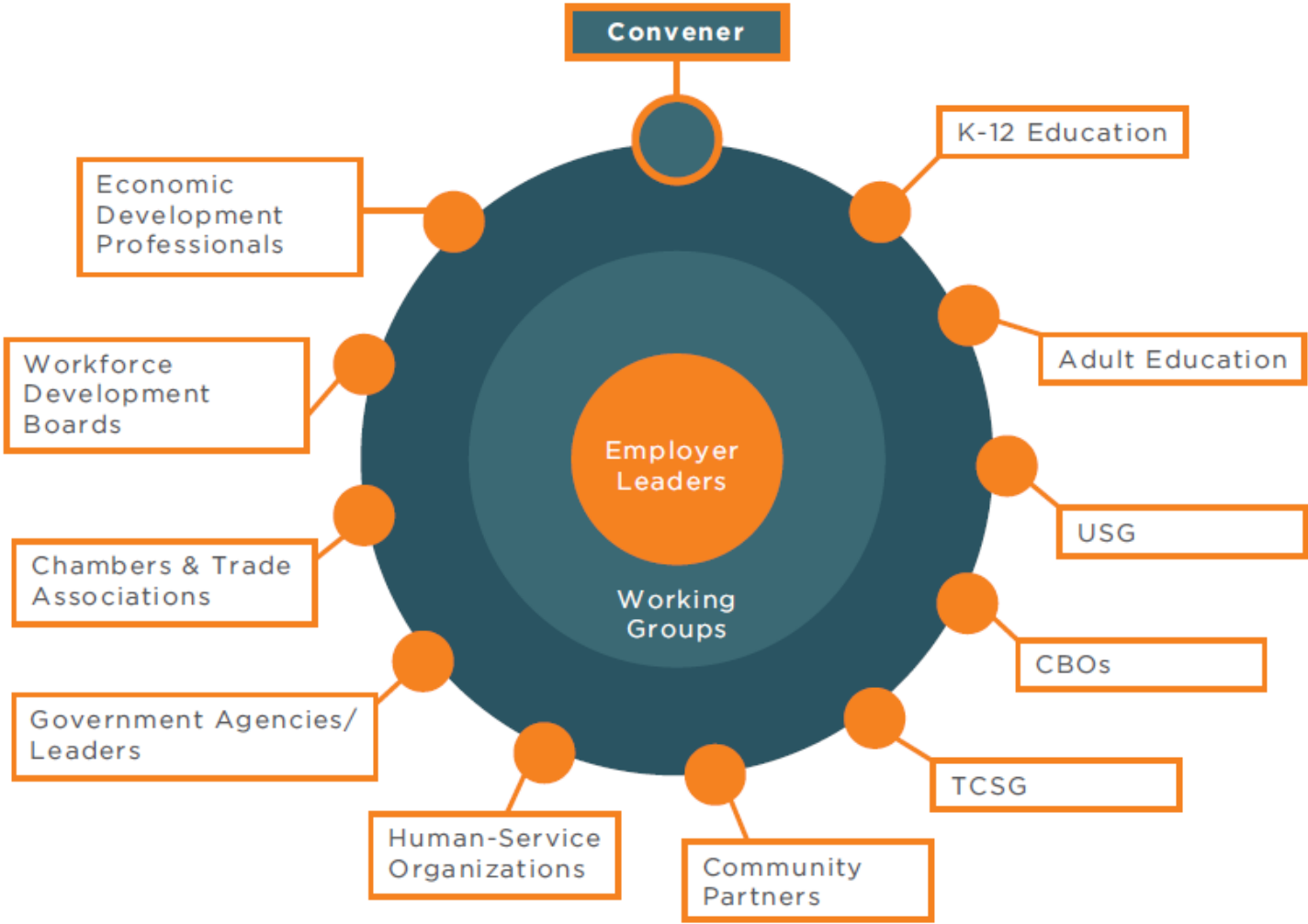

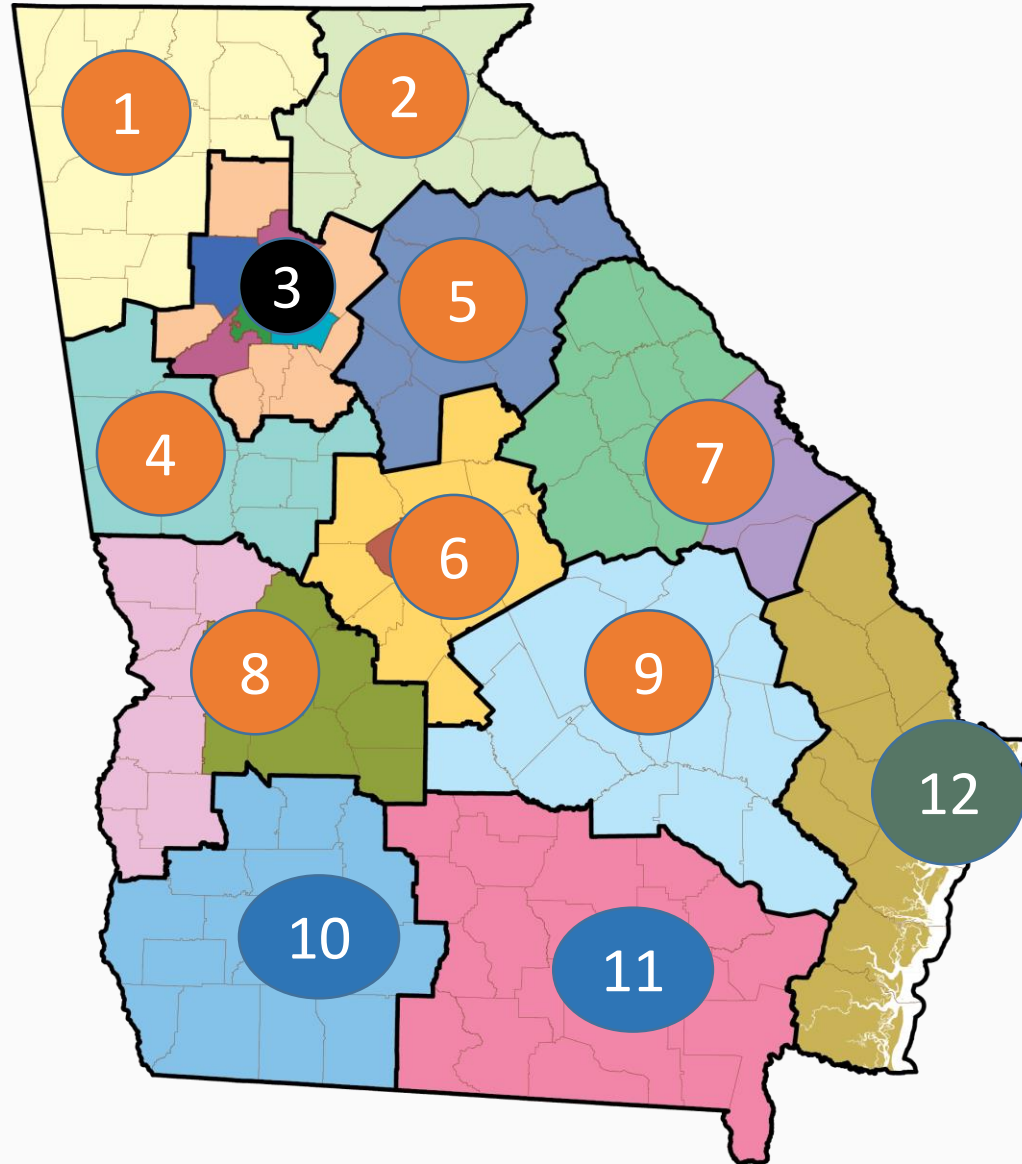
