Important Updates

2nd Cycle Seal of Biliteracy Reporting

May 1 is the reporting deadline for the second cycle of the Georgia Seal of Biliteracy. This reporting cycle is for 2020 graduating seniors who qualify for the Seal of Biliteracy via their AP and/or IB scores. Seniors who earned a 4 or



above on their AP or a 5 or above on their IB scores (SL or HL only). The submission portal to request seals for these students is open and can be accessed via this link. (If your district has a world language coordinator, check with them prior to submitting request to determine district policy.)
