


# **Georgia NAEP Grade 4 Mathematics**

### **C&I Updates: Standards Review Process**

### **Background**

- Summer 2019: Governor Kemp announced he was partnering with the State School Superintendent to review/revise ELA/mathematics standards
- Standards Review/Revision Cycle: Every 4-5 years
- Mathematics standards will be addressed first, then ELA standards
- Establish a Citizens Review Committee

Aligns with Georgia's Online IEP (GO-IEP) application which is also a part of SLDS


