Instructions to Save and Complete GaDOE Self-Assessment Documents Using a Mac Computer

- 1. Be sure that you have the latest version of Adobe Reader 11.0.09 (or the latest version required by your OS or are using Adobe Acrobat Standard or Professional), if not:
 - Go to the <u>Adobe Reader Download website</u> and download version 11 or the latest version for your operating system,
 - Restart your computer.
- 2. Click on the **Desktop** and in the **Finder Menu bar** at the top left of the computer screen,
 - Click on **Go to Folder**,
 - Type in or copy and paste, /Library/Internet Plug-Ins,
 - Click on the **Adobe PDF browser plugin** from the Internet Plug-Ins folder and move it to the trash.
 - Restart your computer and then go to the Self-Assessment webpage using Safari, open each document needed and save them on your Desktop or to a folder.
 - To open each document, right-click on the document and click on **Open with** and select **Adobe Reader 11.0.09** or the Acrobat program you are using, complete the form, click **Save**.
 - On most Mac computers, the default is set for **Preview** to open all pdf documents, hence the need to right click and **Open with** one of the Adobe programs. The forms cannot be filled out in **Preview**.
