*Percentage = Percentage of Students by reason for removal by Disability Area- For example, there were 34 students with Specific Learning Disability (SLD) unilaterally removed to an IAES due to drugs, weapons, or serious bodily injury. 26 of the students with a SLD were removed due to drugs. $26 \div 34 = .7647$ or **76.47%**

**Interim Alternative Education Setting (IAES) and Unilateral Removal¹ - School personnel or a hearing officer may remove a child to an IAES setting [Unilateral Removal¹] for not more than 45 school days without regard to whether the behavior is determined to be a manifestation of the child's disability, for offenses related to weapons, drugs, or inflicting serious bodily injury on another person. [34 C. F. R. § 300.530(g)(1)-(3)]

¹Unilateral Removal is a change in placement made by school personnel or a hearing officer, not the IEP team, for drugs, weapons, or serious bodily injury. The determination of the setting for the IAES is made by the IEP team.
