What is The Purpose of Cross-Functional Monitoring (CFM)



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 Cross functional monitoring serves as a vehicle for the Georgia Department of Education to help LEAs achieve high quality implementation of educational programs utilizing the LEAs' federal allocations.

Cross-Functional Monitoring (CFM) - Cycle

- LEAs monitored on a four-year cycle (approximately 1/4 each year) Note: Some federal programs monitor more frequently. McKinney-Vento grant and the 21st CCLC grant recipients are monitored annually.
- High-Risk LEAs added to current cycle
 - Risk assessment is completed to determine if an LEA falls into the high-risk category.



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CFM Cycle LEAs Identified for CFM - cyclical or risk **LEA** creates **CFM** and implements requirements corrective identified; action plan, if **LEAs trained** needed **Department** provides report **LEAs collect** of visit via documentation **GaDOE** portal GaDOE **Conducts Audit**

- Meet with key LEA personnel and discuss your program and areas that will be reviewed; review CFM indicator document
- Collaborate, Collaborate with Finance Director
- Collect and Organize monitoring documentation
- Conduct a mock monitoring visit ahead of time
- Review old monitoring reports
- Review audits Including Single Audit (formerly known as the A-133 Compliance Audit)
- Be prepared to address any corrective action plans already created or implemented
- Contact your assigned Georgia Department of Education Budget Liaison if you have any questions





Cross Functional Monitoring (CFM)

IDEA Fiscal Monitoring Resources

- The IDEA Fiscal Monitoring Checklist is a simplified resource that explicitly states the required documentation for each IDEA Cross Functional Monitoring Fiscal Indicator.
- The IDEA Fiscal Checklist is very likely to change this year. The updated FY22 IDEA Fiscal Checklist will be posted if any changes are made to CFM requirements.
- LEAs will be notified about any changes that occur to the FY22 IDEA Fiscal Checklist.
- The IDEA Fiscal Checklist does not include the written Internal Control Requirements.






Cross Functional Monitoring (CFM) Where to Submit IDEA Fiscal Documentation



Cross Functional Monitoring (CFM) Where to Submit IDEA Fiscal Documentation - SLDS







Cross Functional Monitoring (CFM) Results Where is the CFM Report Located?


