 - Percent of youth with IEPs aged 16 and above with an IEP that



The End Result? Indicator 14: Postschool Outcomes

- Indicator 14: Postschool Outcomes
- School Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were:
 - (A) Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school;
 - (B) Enrolled in higher education or in (integrated) competitively employed within one year of leaving high school; and
 - (C) Enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school.

 - Who, what, when?
- Are you implementing any predictors of postschool outcomes?
- Do you monitor progress on transition goals?
- Do you let students take the lead in creating and monitoring transition goals?
- Do you have a robust Summary of Performance?

- Are families expecting to hear from you after their child graduates? Families engaged?
- Do you associate your data with the individual student?
- Do you evaluate the effectiveness of your system for finding students?
- Are you using interagency collaboration to monitor and find students?


