The Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency (GVRA) in partnership with the Georgia Department of Education (GADOE) will offer Virtual Job Shadow as a platform for Career Exploration and other pre-employment transition services (Pre-ETS) to students with disabilities in grades 9-12 enrolled in local educational agencies who do not utilize Virtual Job Shadowing as part of their transition services. This collaboration will enhance our ability to ensure that students receiving Pre-ETS have meaningful opportunities to prepare for competitive integrated employment, Indicator 14 of the State Performance Plan. This service is for students who are eligible and potentially eligible for VR services.
