- Summer 2019: Governor Kemp announced he was partnering with the State School Superintendent to review/revise ELA/mathematics standards
- Standards Review/Revision Cycle: Every 4-5 years
- Mathematics standards will be addressed first, then ELA standards
- Establish a Citizens Review Committee

June 2020 Recommendation to the State Board

Convene Working Committees of **Teachers**


November 2019 – January 2020

Content area classroom teachers for each grade level and geographically representative of the state. Equally appointed by the Governor, State School Superintendent, State Board of Education, and Department.




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


Current Stage: Post Public Feedback Survey

• 17,000+ responses:

- 9,500 mathematics; 7,500 ELA; almost 1,000 shares on GaDOE's Facebook page within 24hrs of posting
- Mathematics all but two counties (Talbot, Hancock); ELA – all but one county (Taliaferro)
- 60-70% teachers of the content area surveyed
- 15-20% parents
