CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring GaDOE CNA and Progress Monitoring

The purpose of the progress monitoring tool within the SLDS CLIP application is to place integrated and on-going progress monitoring reports directly in the hands of local educational agencies (LEA) to allow them to track and monitor progress in the implementation of their CLIP action steps.

GaDOE Systems of Continuous Improvement



Process to Improve

Step 4: Implement Plan – carry out the plan to implement the promising solutions, making real-time adjustments where/when needed.

Step 5: Examine Progress- determine whether the implementation of the promising solutions is meeting the originally identified needs of the school.



CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring ESSA Regulations

2 CFR § 200.301 Performance Measurement

- To show achievement of program goals and objectives, share lessons learned, improve program outcomes, and foster adoption of promising practices
- To include any performance measures or independent sources of data that may be used to **measure progress**

2 CFR § 200.329 Monitoring and Reporting Program Performance

- To assure compliance with applicable Federal requirements and [that] **performance expectations** are being achieved
- To allow for a comparison of actual accomplishments to the objectives of a Federal award
- To provide reasons why established goals were not met, if appropriate



CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring Why Progress Monitor?

Progress monitoring involves regularly collecting and analyzing data in order to track progress against identified targets and goals. Performance monitoring can help identify whether key elements of action steps are being implemented as planned and whether the intervention is meeting intermediate goals. Progress monitoring may suggest how the intervention could be adjusted for continuous improvement.

Monitoring Implementation and Impact

Are you meeting on a regular basis to monitor implementation of your action steps?

What does the data say when you monitored implementation?

- What evidence have you collected to determine if adults are implementing with fidelity?
- What evidence have you collected to determine the impact of implementation?

What adjustments are suggested by implementation and impact data? How might these adjustments affect the integrity of results?

How will you communicate progress with stakeholders?



CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring CLIP Progress Monitoring Process

LEAs are encouraged to convene the CLIP stakeholder group to review the status of the CLIP action steps and complete the progress monitoring application.



Involving stakeholders in progress monitoring is a great way to celebrate successes and gather ideas for adjustments!



CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring CLIP Progress Monitoring

New Progress Monitoring Requirement for FY22

• All LEAs will be **required** to submit CLIP progress monitoring during the two progress monitoring reporting periods.

Reporting Periods for CLIP Progress Monitoring

- July 1 December 31 (reporting window is open during the month of January)
- January 1 May 1 (reporting window is open during the month of May)





CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring CLIP Progress Monitoring

When is the Progress Monitoring tool accessible?

 The Progress Monitoring tool is available after a CLIP (Online or S-CLIP) is initially approved by GaDOE.

Who has access to the Progress Monitoring Tool?

 Both the District Administrator and the District Superintendent roles can view, edit, and select the evidence of progress status applicable to each action step of the CLIP.

Action step details and reporting progress:

- 1. Click on View Details to view the description and the details of the goal and the action step.
- Click on Assess Action Item Progress to provide an evidence of progress for the specific action step. There are four drop down options to choose from, along with a text box to provide a narrative summary, if needed or when required.
- 3. Click on Comment History to view the summary of comments included.

- Repeat these steps to add additional needs, goals, and action steps. Note that each identified need must have at least one goal and action step entered into the application. When all action steps are added, select CLOSE.
- Now, you will be able to select the overarching need from the drop down and see the goals and action steps associated with this need. Proceed to the next step to "Assess Action Item Progress".

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CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring Progress Monitoring – Navigating the Application

After assigning a progress status for all action steps in the reporting period, the District Administrator or the District Superintendent will select "Submit to State".





CLIP Monitoring/Evaluating/Progress Monitoring CLIP Progress Monitoring

- The GaDOE Continuous Improvement Teams (CIT) will collaboratively review the CLIP Online progress monitoring submission to understand how the LEA is progressing in implementing its approved plan.
- Once reviewed, comments may be added, and the tool will be reopened for continued use by the LEA for the remainder of the year.

The GaDOE CLIP CIT will review the district's submitted information, add comments, suggestions, or recommendations, and submit to the State Director.
