Title I, Part A provides federal funds through the Georgia Department of Education to local educational agencies (LEAs) and public schools with high numbers or percentages of poor children to help ensure that all children meet challenging State academic content and student academic achievement standards.


- provide all students with access to a well-rounded education,


- ☐ To provide opportunities for *academic enrichment* and *tutorial services*
