

McKinney-Vento Education for Homeless Children and Youth LEA Survey Instructions

Deadline for completion: September 30, 2022

All Georgia local educational agencies (LEAs) are required to submit data on homeless children and youth for the 2021-2022 school year. Please keep in mind that all data submitted for this survey should reflect the 2021-2022 school year only. The homeless survey is part of the electronic consolidated application. The survey is located under the **Data Collection** tab of the **Homeless Education** program. LEAs will maintain all records supporting the requested data submitted in the survey at the local level for five years or until any pending program audits are settled following the five-year period.

The survey is divided into two parts. The first part contains all program data and includes all fields that require LEA data submission. The second part contains academic data related to homeless children and youth within the LEA. Part two will be uploaded by the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) once academic data for the 2021-2022 year are available. Part two does not require action by the LEA.

1.0 Locating and Preparing the Survey

- 1.1 Log into the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) portal <https://portal.doe.k12.ga.us/login.aspx>.
- 1.2 Ensure that the fiscal year reads: **Fiscal Year: 2023**.
- 1.3 Add **Program: Homeless Education** to the consolidated application from the dropdown menu.
- 1.4 Click on the **Program Information** tab.
- 1.5 The 2021-2022 survey is contained within the **Data Collection** sub-tab. The **Homeless** page is selected by default in the **Select Data Collection Form** dropdown box. The final upload for the **Academic Data** page will not be completed until data are officially released by the GaDOE. **Completing this survey does not require navigation to the Academic Data page.**
- 1.6 In the **LEA Homeless Liaison name** text box enter the first and last name of the LEA Homeless Liaison.
- 1.7 In the **Years of experience** dropdown, select the appropriate years of experience for the LEA Homeless Liaison.
- 1.8 Select **Yes** or **No** to denote whether the LEA had any homeless children and/or youth during the 2021-2022 school year. If the LEA did not have any homeless children and/or youth, skip to the Awareness section of the survey. Refer to section **4.0** of this guide for additional guidance on completing the Awareness section.

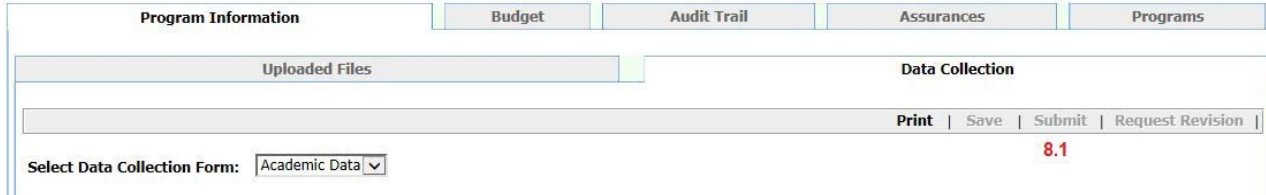

8.0 Submitting the Survey

8.1 Once all required data have been provided, the survey completer must click **Submit** in order to send the survey to the LEA superintendent for approval. (Note: The **Request Revision** function is deactivated for the survey completer and is only available within the superintendent role.)



8.2 The LEA superintendent will either approve the survey by clicking **Submit** or will send the survey back to the survey completed by clicking **Request Revision**. If revisions are requested, the completer must resubmit the survey to the superintendent. Once the superintendent selects **Submit**, the LEA’s survey has been officially completed.
